MODIFICATION OF NO CONTACT ORDER

Steps to follow in order for the No Contact Order To be considered for Modification

1. *Under no circumstances will the Judge consider modifying the no contact order without you first making every attempt to have a safety plan for yourself and your children.*
2. Domestic Violence classes are available to you through the YWCA
3. Contact the Prosecuting attorney for Wapato Municipal Court 509-571-1803 in regards to lifting the No Contact Order and explain why you feel the order should be lifted. The Prosecutor will make those recommendations to the Judge if they feel that you have done everything to protect yourself and children.
4. Once this has been completed and you feel you have a safety plan, then and only then will the Judge consider a hearing with you.
5. By completing the above steps, in no way assures you that the Judge will lift the No Contact Order. Each case that comes before the court is unique and requires individual consideration before a decision can be made.
6. Bring all paperwork to the court office for review and a court date will be set for a future date. The Clerk of Court with help with the case number, you will need to provide the defendants name and date of birth.

**Wapato Municipal Court
DV Victims Procedure for Modification of
No Contact Order**

1. Forms are provided in this packet for you to file with the court in order to have the No Contact Order Modified. Documents must be file stamped at the court office for consideration. It is recommended that you attend and complete a program for Victims of a Domestic Violence act to be considered for Modification.
2. The Judge will review your Motion and you will be notified by mail whether the Judge will grant/deny the motion and/or a court hearing will be scheduled.
3. Should a hearing be scheduled you will be required to attend said hearing as designated otherwise your motion will be denied.
4. You will need to provide to the court at the time of your hearing all necessary paperwork/documents that you have made every attempt to provide a safety plan for yourself and your children.
5. It is your responsibility to provide the court with a current mailing address in order to schedule a modification hearing.
